

Maryland Monoclonal Antibody Treatment Administration Locations for COVID-19

This document lists referral sites for monoclonal antibody treatment administration for COVID-19. For more information about monoclonal antibodies and eligibility requirements, visit <u>covidLINK</u> and view <u>FAQs</u>. A provider must refer you to a site (unless otherwise indicated).

Talk to your health care provider as soon as you test positive for COVID-19 or are aware that you have been exposed to COVID-19 so they can determine if monoclonal antibodies are the right treatment for you.

If you do not have a healthcare provider or would like to self-refer you have several options for seeking treatment.

You may fill out a HIPAA-compliant online referral form through <u>MDmAbs</u>, <u>UMMS/BCCFH</u>, <u>Hatzalah</u>, or <u>Soliel Pharmacy</u>.

You may call FirstCall Medical Center at 443-459-1095 (Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.) or the Maryland Department of Health-supported monoclonal antibody call center at 410-649-6122 (Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.). You may ask to speak with a clinician, who will review your eligibility for monoclonal antibody treatment. If you are eligible, they will either schedule you for infusion treatment at one of the state sites or refer you to another site based on your location.

You may schedule a virtual appointment through <u>eVisit</u>. If it is determined you are eligible, you will be referred to an infusion site.

Locations and availability of treatment is subject to change. Hours of operation may vary.
